

JCRSB determined that for a podiatrist having completed a CPME-approved fellowship relevant to the specialty of a particular board (board A), but whose residency training was relevant to the pathway of the other board (board B); board A may regard that individual as a legitimate examination candidate based upon the nature of their approved fellowship training as determined by the board. The podiatrist must document graduation (by providing signed certificates) from:

- At least two one-year CPME-approved residencies or
- One CPME-approved two-, three-, or four-year residency, and
- A CPME-approved fellowship.

This condition expires in the sunset year of 2018.
